Jo's Story – pollution in our City

The Green Party continues to campaign for clean air. Sadly I meet people who are being blighted by the pollution levels in the city. Jo lives in St Denys and says she is a prisoner in her own home. She has chronic asthma and cannot walk up to the shops at Portswood due to the queueing traffic spewing out fumes along St Denys Road.

Jo said “ Since Sainsbury's opened the traffic seems to have got worse.”

Southampton has one of the highest admission rates for acute asthma in the south east. Recently Southampton City Council decided not to introduce a clean air zone – this was bad news for Jo and Jack who I wrote about in the last leaflet.

What is the Labour administration doing about these issues – launching a Green City Charter full of fine words and no concrete plans.

Pedestrianisation of Portswood High St

Over the past weeks Green Party members have been canvassing opinion from shopkeepers on this topic.

Our high street is dying – shops are closing and being replaced with cafes, bars and take away food stores. The last banking business goes in May. In towns where pedestrianisation has been done well this has resulted in a 35% increase in footfall and a significant increase in profitability for the businesses.

Portswood High St has some fantastic businesses, the wedding shop, the guitar shop, an independent book shop, Kays mini market, Ashleigh Opticians and the fruit and veg shop.
